WORK SESSION MEETING
Tuesday, June 9, 2015
8:00 a.m.

The North Montgomery Board of School Trustees met at the Central Administration Office, 480 West 580 North, Crawfordsville, Indiana. Representing the Administration was Superintendent Dr. Colleen Moran, Director of Business and Transportation Jim McBee, Director of Technology Craig Reich, and Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment Coordinator Robin Mills. Members present: Gary Bohlander, Jill Davis, Terresa Hatke, Gerald Hole, Karin Kerber Odle, Michael Shepherd, and Richard VanArsdel.

WORK SESSION

1. Mr. VanArsdel called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.
2. Dr. Moran shared the survey statistics from the three county school districts for the 2016-2017 calendar. No action was taken.
3. Dr. Moran discussed a marketing campaign to attract prospective families to NMCSC. No action was taken.
4. Dr. Moran reviewed existing Board policies that address the role of NMCSC personnel when students and/or parents engage in a physical altercation. Dr. Moran reminded the Board that all school staff is trained annually in non-violent crisis intervention. No action was taken.
5. Dr. Moran reviewed the job description for the CIA (Curriculum, Instruction, & Assessment Coordinator). No action was taken.
6. Mr. Craig Reich described several scenarios for expand the 1:1 iPad initiative for grades K-5. No action was taken.
7. Dr. Moran discussed various options that are available for online courses through APEX, the IN Online Academy and other resources. Mr. VanArsdel cited a resource found at the AASA Conference that also provides SAT preparation online courses. No action was taken.
8. Dr. Moran updated the Board on the West Central Career & Technical Education Cooperative that will be presented at the Board meeting scheduled for June 22, 2015 for approval. She explained the Ivy Tech tuition-free Manufacturing Boot Camp and paid internships for 2015 graduates. She also discussed her vision for the Crawfordsville Ivy Tech to become a Career Center for area high school students and the workforce. No action was taken.
9. Dr. Moran discussed future visions collected from feedback from the current principals. No action was taken.
